DIY Intervention Risks



- Significant Limitations
- Minimal chances of effective treatment

Limitations on Family Learning with DIY Interventions





- Addiction education
- Developing communication among family members
- Setting boundaries
- Handling objections and manipulations



Importance of Professional Help



- Managing volatility of early sobriety attempts
- Ongoing support
- Family recovery







- Minimal accomplishments
- Short-term vs. long-term effectiveness
- Success rate
